Instrumental/Booster Meeting Minutes
May 2, 2023

Call Meeting to Order: Jessica Harless at 7:06pm in the John Glenn High School band room.

Meeting Minutes: *Motion by Bethany Liligren seconded Jessica West to approve the April 4, 2023 meeting minutes with correction to outstanding 2022 date as noted. Motion Passed*

Old Business:

- Need a Fundraiser Chair
- Egg My Yard: Gross was \$6,725, Net profit after expenses and Paypal Fees was \$4,234.97.
 - Prepped for 10k eggs, sold 8,875 and donated 200. Cost per egg was .177.
 - Left over candy and bracelets will be used at banquet. Left over eggs have been stored for next year.
 - No major complaints, one minor issue that was resolved that night.
 - Donation yard, family was incredibly grateful they had an abundance of eggs between the Girl Scouts and JGHS Music
 - Suggestion for next year: Have kids bring Flashlights!

Director's Report:

- Congratulations to Drama students, they did a phenomenal job!!
- Next year teaching: 2 bands, 2 orchestra, and choir
- Directors and JGHS students went to all 3 middle schools to fit students for instruments and getting kids excited about the instruments. Received positive feedback from the other Directors wherever they went, so we appreciate their efforts for that.
- Good News: Tomorrow we open uniform bids!!
 - We don't think they'll have them in by the fall, possibly by late fall
 - We have some ideas for what we might do as an alternative

 - *Motion by Mr. McConnel seconded by Lillian Rivers to start requiring an additional administrative fee of 3% as a PayPal convenience fee as of July 1st. Motion Passed.*

 - We are changing our reservation down to 3.
 - We're currently trying to get our \$450 (\$250 Boosters, \$200 front office) deposit back for the 4th person we reserved.
